

The following attempts to outline all fees applicable during a school year. Any omissions and errors are unintentional. Fees may still be required for participation in the applicable activity, course, service, or group where errors or omissions have occurred.

Amounts payable to the Heritage Christian Education Society Calgary are based on the current agreement with Palliser Regional Schools; if this agreement changes, contributions will be subject to change.

**NEW APPLICANTS:**

**1. Application Fee (non-refundable)**

**\$100.00 per family** (for new applicants)

This fee covers processing costs. To be submitted with the application forms.

**2. Placement Testing Fee**

**\$75/student to max. \$150/family** (for new applicants in grades 2-12)

This fee covers the cost of test materials and processing fees. To be submitted with the application forms.

**ALL STUDENTS:**

**1. Heritage Christian Education Society Calgary (HCESC) Fee**

**\$ 200.00 per family** (to be paid in combination with the Christian Education Program Contribution below under the selected payment method)

**2. Christian Education Program Contribution**

(10% deposit due upon acceptance or re-registration in February with the balance due August 1 or according to a 10 month payment schedule)

**3. Refundable Enrolment Bond**

In order to fund capital projects and initiatives that benefit all students, HCA requires families to contribute to a refundable bond program. The monies invested are returned to families upon a student's graduation or departure from HCA. The bond is deferred for students in Kindergarten until Grade 1. For students in Grade 1, the bond is paid in two installments: \$1,500 due prior to the start of Grade 1 and \$1,500 due prior to beginning Grade 2. The enrolment bond is capped at \$3,000 per student and \$6,000 total investment per family.

For some families, financial circumstances may not support up front payment of the bond. Consideration will be given to those families that can demonstrate financial need in regard to the bond requirement. Application for alternative bond payment arrangements can be made as part of our financial assistance program.
